TOURNAMENT RULES

General:

1. Timekeeping is the responsibility of the host Club.
2. All pool quarters and semi-finals will start and stop on the hooter. Finals will be to the referee's time keeping.
3. Please be ready to start on the hooter.
4. Referees are to be supplied by the host club.
5. Referees decisions are final. The results recorded on the Referee's game card are final.
6. 7 aside with up to three substitutes.
7. Size 3 balls 7-9 grade. Size 4 balls 10th grade.
8. Field size approximately 60m long by 40m wide with junior size goals.

Game Rules:

9. Rolling substitutes when ball is out. Player must have left field before substitutes enter.
10. The referees decision is final.
11. All players must wear boots and shin pads.
12. Goalkeepers only to be changed at half time.
13. No supports or coaches behind goals. No coaching on the field of play.
14. Any Team not on the field when the hooter goes will find the ball is deemed in play, & the late team may be disqualified for that game and 3 points and 3 goals awarded to the opposing team.
15. Offside rule applies at referee's discretion. Only blatant offside will be called.
16. Goal kick to be taken out of hands or off the ground.
17. All throw-ins must be correct. Blatant foul throws will be called and a re-throw will be offered.
18. No dispensated players will be accepted.
19. All players must be a Financial Member of their club.
20. Visiting Teams must provide Alt Spare strip, in case of a clash of colours.

POOL PLAY

10 minutes each way – 2 minutes for half time

In the event of even points at the end of pool play, final positions will be decided by: -

1. Highest number of goals for
2. If the goals are the same and their game was drawn in pool play then highest corners for
3. If still undecided then toss of a coin

POST SECTION KNOCKOUT

Quarter/ Semi finals are 10 minutes each way – 2 minutes for half time

Finals are 12 minutes each way with 2 minutes half time.

If the two teams are tied after full time in knockout rounds the result will be decided by:

1. 5 minutes of extra time with Golden Goal Rules. Teams change ends from when they finish normal time. The first team to score a goal wins. (No other games to start until result is found).
2. If neither team scores in extra time, we move to penalties, three from each team at nine metres.
3. If the scores are still level then we move to sudden death penalties, if the first teams player scores and the opposition teams player misses, then game is over.
